Memphis Chapter Tuskegee Airmen Inc. 2023 Captain Calvin Janes Scholarship Instructions

The Memphis Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen, Inc. (MCTAI) and Taste of Aviation, Inc. (TOA) is sponsoring a \$1000.00 Captain Calvin Janes College Scholarship Assistance Award to a high school student in the mid-south region who has a financial need, will graduate from high school in the school year 2022 - 2023 and will be attending an accredited college in 2023. The purpose of this fund is to help defer some of the costs involved in attending college.

Interested applicants should fill out the 2023 CAPTAIN CALVIN JANES SCHOLARSHIP application on the reverse side and submit it along with the required attachments and other documentation to MCTAI. As a guideline, some of the required criteria as well as instructions for the application process are explained below.

After this scholarship is awarded, it will be paid on a refund basis to or on behalf of the recipient. Students must successfully complete the college courses with a grade of "C" or better in order to receive payment. A transcript from the college attended showing grades received will be required prior to any funds being disbursed. The college must be an accredited school that is recognized by MCTAI. When the required verifications have been received, the award payments, made payable to the student and/or college, will be mailed to the address designated by the student. All required documents for payment of scholarship awards must be received within one year from date of selection notification. Note: "college" can be a university or other MCTAI recognized educational institution of higher learning.

Application Procedure (Read before Completing Application Form)

Information on application form must be typed or neatly and legibly printed in black ink.

<u>Part I</u>, of the attached application form must be completed by <u>all student applicants</u>.

<u>Part II</u> is to be completed by the parent(s), guardian or individual that claims the student applicant as a dependent on the IRS Form 1040.

Official Copy of High School Transcript and senior year Schedule .
A two (2) page essay (typed (10 or 12 font), double-spaced with 1 inch margins on 8.5"x 11" paper) with one (1) page
containing: your brief biographical sketch, educational aspirations, career goals, explanation of why financial aid is
essential to you, and one (1) page containing: comments or information about one or more notable African American
Pioneers or Legends in the field of aviation and how he, she, or they have impacted you.
List of Extracurricular & Community Activities other than Junior ROTC, Civil Air Patrol, BSA, GSA or Explorer Scouts
Three letters of recommendation (From Counselors, Instructors, Community Leaders. etc.)
A copy of parent(s)' or guardian's and if applicable, student applicant's latest IRS Form 1040 (2022 form preferable)
through adjusted gross income line. Do not send all other IRS pages. If not required to file Form 1040, provide
official alternate source document to verify income, such as statement from Public Social Services, Pensions or SSI (W-2
or W-4 not acceptable). SSN should be "blacked out".

Informal interviews with applicants may be conducted prior to approval of awards. Any falsification of information on the application form or on any required documentation throughout the funding process will be grounds for the rejection of the application and or withdrawal of funding awards by MCTAI.
