Memphis Chapter Tuskegee Airmen Inc. 2024 College Assistance Fund Instructions

The Memphis Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen Inc. (MCTAI) is offering \$1000.00 College Assistance Funds to high school students in the mid-south region who has a financial need, will graduate from high school in the school year 2023 - 2024 and will be attending an accredited college in 2024. The purpose of this fund is to help defer some of the costs involved in attending college.

Interested applicants should fill out the APPLICATION FOR TUSKEGEE AIRMEN SCHOLARSHIP FUND application on the reverse side and submit it along with the other required documentation to MCTAI. As a guideline some of the required criteria as well as instructions for the application process are explained below.

An applicant can only apply for one, MCTAI College Assistance Fund. Once a fund is awarded, it will be issued on a refund basis. Students must successfully complete the college courses with a grade of "C" or better in order to receive payment. A transcript from the college showing grade received will be required prior to any funds being disbursed. MCTAI will reimburse only that amount that is not already covered by other grants, scholarships, Veterans Administration benefits or tuition refund programs. The college must be an accredited school that is recognized by MCTAI.

Applications must be submitted with all required documentation by March 1, 2024.

Application Procedure (Read before Completing Application Form)

Information on application form must be typed or neatly and legibly printed in black ink.

Part I, of the attached application form must be completed by all student applicants.

Part II is to be completed by the parent(s), guardian or individual that claims the student applicant as a dependent on the IRS Form 1040.

Additional Required Documents

Each student applicant must write and submit a two (2) page essay containing: a brief biographical sketch, educational aspirations, career goals and an explanation of why financial aid is essential. <u>Essays must be typed (10 or 12 font), double-spaced with 1 inch margins on white 8.5"x 11" paper.</u>

To validate the financial status of the applicant, a copy of the most recent parent(s) or guardian's and if applicable, student applicant's IRS Form 1040 (last one filed with the IRS) must be submitted.

To validate student grades an official copy of the High School transcript must be submitted.

Applications must be submitted along with all required documentation (postmarked) by March 1, 2024 to:

Incomplete application packets will not be processed.

All application packets must include the following:

- Completed Application Form (Part I and Part II)
- __ Typed (2) page essay on 8.5" x 11" white paper, double-spaced (10 or 12 font) by student applicant
- ___ Official Copy of High School Transcript and List of Extracurricular and Community Activities (ROTC, CAP, BSA, etc.)
- __ Copy of the Parent(s) latest IRS Form1040 through adjusted gross income line. SSN should be "blacked out".

Approval Process

MCTAI will notify all applicants by mail with regard to scholarship awards. MCTAI reserves the right to verify information that has been submitted by the student applicant. A MCTAI representative needing to verify information so as to complete the application process may contact applicants. Informal interviews with applicants may be conducted prior to approval of awards. Any falsification of information on the application form or on any required documentation throughout the funding process will be grounds for the rejection of the application and or withdrawal of funding awards by MCTAI.

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
